Our guest speaker, after formalities, is Doctor Robert Bush, recent past secretary of the Queensland Ornithological Society, member of the Queensland Wader Study Group Management Committee and Australasian Wader Study Group Board. Locally, Robert is often found cycling around the island each month with QWSG volunteers banding and monitoring the movements of our bush stone curlews.

His presentation, "Tracking Shorebirds tells us how they live and survive in Moreton Bay: There has never been a more important time to use this information to support conservation of the Bay." **HAVE YOUR SAY** on the health of the environment in the review of South-east Queensland's Natural Resource Management Plan (SEQ NRM Plan) being coordinated by Healthy Land and Water. <u>SEQ NRM Plan Review (arcgis.com)</u>. **The survey will close on June 15** and if you provide your name and contact details you go into the draw for one of four \$250 vouchers.
