Environmental Hub underway

Planning is well underway for the development of Coastcare's Environmental Hub, discretely set-back amongst vegetation on Elizabeth Street, adjacent to the gravel track to Laurie Burns Recreation Reserve, opposite the Energex depot.

Surveying will be undertaken next week and engineering assessment in January. Last month Coastcare signed the Licence to Occupy with Redland City Council as a precursor to our Lease and look forward to construction in 2024.

Subject to investigation, it's hoped to incorporate the existing concrete slab in the footprint

covering 34 square metres of bush-fringed land. We're excited to enter the preconstruction phase for this long-awaited facility to store our saturated steam weeder, storage trailer and accumulated equipment as well as community meeting place. Thanks to all who have contributed time and effort over so many years to bring this project to fruition. Initial work on site development and Stage One construction is being funded by a Capital Infrastructure grant (Minor) from Redland City Council. Further detail found at http://eepurl.com/h 2VKn
